Wilson Arch Community,

The contract for water upgrades are anticipated to start in the next 30-60 days. Having said that, we are reaching out to inform you that there will be a lot of digging primarily along Back of the Arch Drive. This is to install a new 8" water line and fire hydrants. Additionally, you will see some digging along property easements to install water meters for the connected lots. Water meters are a state requirement and must be installed by the year 2030.

We will have to stage equipment and supplies in order to accomplish this and will readdress this with the contractor to minimize any congestion. We ask that you are patient as we work through all of this.

Any correspondence throughout this process will be by email only. So, please make sure your contact information is updated. This will be our means of informing you when water is shut off as well as any additional information associated with the install process. We understand there may be some inconvenience, but this will be a huge improvement for the community.

We ask that all residents currently connected to check the water systems within their homes to ensure they have a water pressure regulator installed on the main line coming into the house. And for those that have a standard water heater, (not tankless), there is an expansion tank installed. (see figure 1 and 2). These items are required by code and should have been installed when the plumbing went in. They prevent damage to your plumbing as well as any appliances connected. The SSD is not responsible for any damages associated with improper plumbing procedures within the connected residents' homes.

Thus, some exploratory excavating might have to be done to locate lines, meter locations, etc. Installation will only be on easements and rights of way as approved by the state and county.
